**INTERPRETIVE STATEMENT ISSUED**

The department of revenue has reissued the following excise tax advisory (ETA):

**ETA 3043.2018 - Low-Density Light and Power Utility Deduction**

The department of revenue has revised ETA 3043. This ETA explains the public utility tax deduction provided by RCW 82.16.053 to qualifying power and light businesses.

RCW 82.16.053 requires the department to determine the state average electric power rate each year and inform taxpayers of this rate. This rate is used by power and light businesses to compute the amount of the deduction. The revised ETA 3043 updates the information to provide the rate for the period of July 1, 2018, through June 30, 2019.

Effective Date: August 1, 2018.

Description: The health care authority in conjunction with the aging and long-term services administration in the department of social and health services intend to submit medicaid SPA 18-0014 to update information regarding intermediate care facilities for individuals with intellectual disabilities (ICF/IID).

In order to be certified as an ICF/IID, a facility must meet the conditions of participation described in 42 C.F.R. §§ 483.400 through 483.480. Facilities that do not meet the applicable conditions of participation are subject to sanctions. Sanctions include termination or nonrenewal of their provider contract, or alternative sanctions when the facility's deficiencies do not pose immediate jeopardy to residents' health and safety.

Per request from the Centers for Medicare and Medicaid Services, SPA 18-0014 will add two alternative sanctions for ICF/IID that are not in compliance with the required conditions of participation: Temporary management, and receivership. Temporary management will allow the state to have a person placed in the facility who has the capability to operate the facility in a manner to gain compliance with the regulations. Receivership will allow the state to engage an entity to operate the facility in a manner to gain compliance with the regulations.

SPA 18-0014 is expected to have no effect on the annual aggregate expenditures/payments for services in ICF/IID facilities.
