The Pollution Prevention for Healthy People and Puget Sound Act (chapter 70.365 RCW) requires the department of ecology (ecology) to submit a report to the legislature by June 1, 2020, that identifies priority consumer products. It also requires ecology to notify the public about the selected products, including the identification of the peer-reviewed science and other sources of information that the department relied upon, the basis for the selection, and a draft schedule for making future determinations. This notice fulfills the notice requirement of RCW 70.365.050 (4)(a).

Ecology published a draft report on January 17, 2020, and held a forty-five day public comment period ending March 2, 2020, to allow stakeholders and the public to review and comment on the draft priority consumer products selected. After considering the comments received on the draft report, ecology conducted additional research and consulted with the Washington department of health. Based on this additional work, ecology identified eleven priority consumer products for further evaluation and potential regulation.
