Subject of Possible Rule Making: Amend chapter 200-100 WAC, Selfinsurance transactions as to local governments.

Statutes Authorizing the Agency to Adopt Rules on this Subject: RCW 48.62.061 Rule making by state risk manager—Standards.

Reasons Why Rules on this Subject may be Needed and What They Might Accomplish: Update of the rules is necessary to align with statutory changes; including, but not limited to, allowing the state board of pilotage commissioners to participate in a local government selfinsurance program covering liability risks. Other content changes are needed to align with recent changes to other self-insurance rules addressing purchasing requirements and independent audit requirements.

Other Federal and State Agencies that Regulate this Subject and the Process Coordinating the Rule with These Agencies: The department of enterprise services (DES) will communicate and coordinate with the office of insurance commissioner, which has an interest in the rules governing joint self-insurance programs, as necessary. DES will also communicate with the state auditor's office, which is currently responsible for financial and accountability audits of local governments.

Process for Developing New Rule: DES will provide an opportunity for anyone interested to provide input as the rule changes are developed. An opportunity will also be provided for anyone to submit written comments on the proposed rules during the formal public comment period and present oral testimony at a virtual public hearing. The public is encouraged to participate in all agency rule making. Opportunities to participate in agency rule-making activities are provided on the DES rule-making website https://des.wa.gov/about/policies-lawsrules/rulemaking.
