**PREPROPOSAL STATEMENT OF INQUIRY**  
**DEPARTMENT OF**

(Aging and Long-Term Support Administration)

Subject of Possible Rule Making: The department of social and health services (DSHS) is creating rules in a new chapter in Title 388 WAC for the long-term services and supports trust program (WA Cares). This rule making will address maximum rates for approved services provided by registered providers, and other related rules as appropriate.

Statutes Authorizing the Agency to Adopt Rules on this Subject: RCW 50B.04.020 (3)(j).

Reasons Why Rules on this Subject may be Needed and What They Might Accomplish: DSHS must adopt rules to establish rates for each approved service, and to consider commission recommendations related to maximum rates, usual and customary rates, regional differences, an exception process, and other topics necessary to adopt rates for WA Cares approved services.

Other Federal and State Agencies that Regulate this Subject and the Process Coordinating the Rule with These Agencies: Employment security department; health care authority. Coordination will occur between departments for consistent implementation of the WA Cares program under chapter 50B.04 RCW.

Process for Developing New Rule: DSHS welcomes the public to take part in developing the rules. Anyone interested should contact the staff person identified below. At a later date, DSHS will file a proposal with the office of the code reviser with a notice of proposed rule making. A copy of the proposal will be sent to everyone on the mailing list and to anyone who requests a copy.
