Subject of Possible Rule Making: WAC 182-502-0010 When the medic-aid agency enrolls and 182-502-0016 Continuing requirements; other related rules as appropriate.

Statutes Authorizing the Agency to Adopt Rules on this Subject: RCW 41.05.021 and 41.05.160.

Reasons Why Rules on this Subject may be Needed and What They Might Accomplish: The health care authority (agency) is revising these rules to provide more clarity on the business license requirement to become a medicaid enrolled provider. During this review, the agency may identify additional related changes that improve clarity or update policy.
