Subject of Possible Rule Making: Student code of conduct and student disciplinary procedures.

Statutes Authorizing the Agency to Adopt Rules on this Subject: RCW 34.05.010(16) and 28B.50.140(13).

Reasons Why Rules on this Subject may be Needed and What They Might Accomplish: To bring the Seattle Colleges student conduct code, chapter 132F-121 WAC, into compliance with reissuing of the final rule issued by the United States Department of Education pursuant to its authority under Title IX of the Education Amendments of 1972, and to update other provisions of the student conduct code to reflect current issues and needs of the college district and its students.
